Subject	Typical homework may include
Art	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Researching artists and their work• Finding images• Revisiting classwork to check understanding
DT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Homework will be set twice per unit, one of which will be to revise for the end of unit quiz, completed for each rotation• For Food Preparation, students are expected to bring in the ingredients each week
Drama	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reflection tasks• Research tasks• End of unit written self-reflection sheets
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Revision linked to quizzes based on the knowledge organisers for each unit that students are provided in class.
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete relevant tasks from their learning journal.• Homework menus (students choose their tasks from a selection given over a longer period of time)• Tasks that consolidate learning from within the lesson• Extra research• Students should aim to watch the news regularly to remain up to date with geographical issues happening globally.
History	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Knowledge retrieval quizzes• Revision work• Supported research• Written and non-written tasks to extend and consolidate class based learning• Online quizzes opportunities to develop skills• Finishing work from class
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Questions that recap and review work that has previously been taught with appropriate challenge and extension material• This could be in written form or electronic e.g. mymaths
Modern Foreign Languages	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Vocabulary learning, with an associated task to practice• Research• Online quizzes• Reading task• Listening task (with audio or video)• Writing task• Speaking task
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Research tasks• Practical tasks linked to guitar, keyboard, and singing• Lyric writing
Personal Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No homework in core PD
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No homework in core PE homework• Students should ensure they bring named PE kit each lesson
Reading (Y7 & Y8)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reading fiction for pleasure• Completing reading records, with a signature from an adult

RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recapping tasks • Retrieval tasks • Research
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homework will mainly be set on Kerboodle via www.kerboodle.co.uk • Each student's username is their initial and surname e.g. gmitchell. Their password is the same as the username the first time students log on and then they can reset their own password, we suggest something easy to remember • The institution code is xsi0 (zero at the end not the letter O) • If students forget their password, it can be reset by their science teacher or by emailing gmitchell@bradfield.sheffield.sch.uk
