Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Page 11 in students' booklets gives them a choice to reflect on what they have been learning.• Exam questions and case study work• Microsoft Forms quizzes at the end of a section.
Citizenship	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Research tasks• Recapping learning• Staying abreast of current affairs
Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recap lesson material• Programming tasks
DT, Engineering and Food	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This will take on a variety of forms depending on the units that are being taught.• A common homework is to complete exam style questions, linked to the theoretical work done in class.
Drama	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Self-reflection sheets• Coursework completion• Rehearsals in school
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A variety of activities set for homework based on low stakes quizzing and retrieval practice, based on the knowledge organisers for each unit.• Further reading ideas• Longer writing tasks will be set when appropriate
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Exam style questions• Knowledge retrieval quizzes• Extra research• Revision• Students should aim to watch the news regularly to remain up to date with geographical issues happening globally
Health and Social Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Independent work on coursework• Set tasks for exam preparation
History	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Knowledge retrieval quizzes• Revision work• Supported research• Written and non-written tasks to extend and consolidate class based learning• Online quizzes opportunities to develop skills• Finishing work from class
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Questions that recap and review work that has previously been taught with appropriate challenge and extension material▪ This could be written form or electronic e.g. mymaths.▪ Relevant exam style questions.

Modern Foreign Languages – French and Spanish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Vocabulary learning, with an associated task to practice ● Research ● Online quizzes ● Reading task ● Listening task (with audio or video) ● Writing task ● Speaking
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Composition tasks ● Instrumental and vocal regular practice ● Music theory / elements revision ● Listening tasks linked to area of study
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Multiple choice and short answer questions where students are expected to recall knowledge. (BTech and GCSE) ● Exam style questions (GCSE) ● No homework is set in Core PE
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recapping tasks (GCSE) ● Retrieval tasks (GCSE) ● Some extended writing tasks (GCSE) ● No homework in core RE (Y0)
Science (all disciplines)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Homework may be set on Kerboodle via www.kerboodle.co.uk ● Each student's username is their initial and surname e.g. gmitchell. Their password is the same as the username the first time students log on and then they can reset their own password, we suggest something easy to remember ● The institution code is xsi0 (zero at the end not the letter O) ● If students forget their password, it can be reset by their science teacher or by emailing gmitchell@bradfield.sheffield.sch.uk ● Homework may also be set on Century Tech www.century.tech ● Students log in by selecting Office 365 and using their school email sign in ● Exam style questions
